

As of Sunday, May 9th at 11:59 pm, <u>outdoor sports and recreation</u>, including golf, is <u>limited to members of your household; or if living</u> <u>alone, to two close contacts</u>. Players will be required to verify that these rules have been adhered to at check-in.

# **REVISED GUIDELINES**

Effective May 10<sup>th</sup>, we will be booking online or by phone for twosome play only. Players will be required to verify that their group adheres to the underlined policy above. Single players and groups of more than two that adhere to the AHS requirements should call the Pro Shop at (403) 256-2002.

#### CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse is open for check-in and washroom use only. **Masks are mandatory in the clubhouse at all times**. Social distancing guidelines are in effect at all times. The locker room area is open for Members only. Maximum 3 people in locker room at a time.

### FOOD & BEVERAGE

As per recent AHS Guidelines, we are able to serve you in a take-out capacity from the Crossover Grill, our halfway house. It is in full operation for service before, during and after your round. While on course, and for ease of service, we recommend players call 15 minutes in advance of pick up time. (403) 256-2002 ext 2. As of May 10, 2021, there is **no indoor dining area or patio** available.

### **DRIVING RANGE**

The practice facility is open with limited stall availability. As per AHS, stalls have been reserved for those playing the golf course. For those who wish to practice only, stalls must be booked in 30 minute sessions by calling (403) 256-2002. The practice putting green is open and players are required to use their own golf balls and maintain social distance at all times.

### POWER CARTS

As of Monday May 10, power carts are mandatory for play at Heritage Pointe. This measure is in place to assist with pace of play with our revised intervals and twosome booking rules. All public health measures must be adhered to.



## ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN PROTOCOLS

Please share this document with all players in group prior to arrival at the club.

All players should arrive no more than 20 minutes prior to their time. Those who do not may be asked to turn around or will be required to wait in their vehicle until 20 minutes before their tee time, depending on space availability. If possible, please do not park directly beside another vehicle that is arriving or departing. Please follow signage and staff instructions at all times. Please be on time for all tee times.

#### All players will be required to handle their own clubs at all times.

**For public players**, we will have tap enabled debit machines to complete your purchase. For those who have created a credit card on file, we can also charge that card upon arrival and email a receipt.

**If dangerous weather** is approaching while on course, please immediately return to your vehicle and take cover. On-course shelters do not provide adequate space for social distancing.

**Players are asked to please move efficiently** prior to tee off to ensure physical distancing requirements are maintained in all areas and congregating is not allowed at any time, as per AHS.

**No loose tees, ball markers or divot repair tools** will be available or provided. Scorecards will be provided on power carts or first tee.

**No accessories available on course**. Ball washers, rakes, water fountains, etc. have all been removed. Benches are not be used.

**Physical distancing** and other requirements will be monitored by staff on course. Physical distancing rules also apply when dealing with staff members.

We are all very fortunate to be able to continue golfing during these challenging times. The safety of our patrons and our staff is our top priority and these rules will be enforced. We appreciate your continued adherence to these rules and look forward to seeing you, from 6 ft away, on your next visit.
