

Covid-19 Rules & Protocols Updated June 10, 2021

CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse and pro shop is open for check-in and washroom use and the patio is open for outdoor dining. Masks are mandatory in the clubhouse at all times. Social distancing guidelines are in effect at all times. The locker room area is open for Members only. Maximum 6 people in locker room at a time.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

As per recent AHS Guidelines, indoor and outside dining is now allowed and we are also able to serve you in a take-out capacity from the Crossover Grill, our halfway house. It is in full operation for service before, during and after your round. While on course, and for ease of service, we recommend players call 15 minutes in advance of pick up time. (403) 256-2002 ext 2. As per AHS, tables must be limited to 6 people maximum. There are no restrictions as to who they are.

DRIVING RANGE

The main driving range is closed for the remainder of the season for renovations. The rest of the practice facility is open. Warm up stations have been installed on the first tee box of each nine. Players are advised to arrive on their starting 10 minutes early to utilize the warm up stations. The practice putting green is open and players are required to use their own golf balls and maintain social distance at all times.

POWER CARTS

There are no longer any restrictions on power carts at Heritage Pointe. All groups are now expected to use 2 carts total. Plastic dividers are available for extra comfort and safety. Masks should be worn at all times when distancing is not possible. Any players, except those who have booked as singles, will be subject to a full cart fee (\$40) if they choose to ride alone, based on availability.

ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN PROTOCOLS

Please share this document with all players in group prior to arrival at the club.

All players will be required to handle their own clubs at all times.

For public players, we will have tap enabled debit machines to complete your purchase. For those who have created a credit card on file, we can also charge that card upon arrival and email a receipt.

If dangerous weather is approaching while on course, please immediately return to your vehicle and take cover. On-course shelters do not provide adequate space for social distancing.

Players are asked to please move efficiently prior to tee off to ensure physical distancing requirements are maintained in all areas.

No loose tees, ball markers or divot repair tools will be available or provided. Scorecards will be provided on power carts or first tee.

Limited accessories available on course. Ball washers, water fountains, etc. have all been removed. Rakes are BACK out on course for use.

The safety of our patrons and our staff is our top priority and these rules will be enforced. We appreciate your continued adherence to these rules and look forward to seeing you, from 6 ft away, on your next visit.
